RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ALL CLASSES MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF 15 SHOOTERS TO QUALIFY FOR CONTINGENCY MONEY
2. Shooters must register at the Bowtech booth when on location prior to the start of their first course or tournament day.
3. All participants must display a Bowtech or Diamond logo on their shirts on the podium.
4. All participants must use a Bowtech or Diamond bow for the entire tournament. At the discretion of Bowtech, the participant may be required to have a member of their shooting group confirm the equipment used.
5. Official 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers only will be awarded contingency monies. The placing determined by the shoot-off, or however the organization determines their placing, will be the standard used.
6. Recipient must claim contingency money from the shooting staff coordinator at Bowtech within 30 days of the tournament.
7. Additional information, including Social Security number, may be required.
8. Bowtech may at any time, and at its sole discretion, cancel or include additional divisions, classes and/or tournament events in the contingency program.
